Lamplight Mission Area - Pilgrimage Walk

The Lamplight Mission Area stretches from Worsborough to Wentworth and includes the parishes of Worsbrough St Thomas & St James with St Lukes, St Mary's Worsbrough Village, St Peter's Hoyland, Holy Trinity Elsecar with St Andrew's Hoyland, and Holy Trinity Wentworth. As the name suggests, our vision is for the churches to bring the light of Christ to our communities, and it also hints at our industrial mining heritage.

On Saturday 28 March we invite you to join us for a walk through our lovely countryside from Worsbrough to Wentworth via Hoyland and Elsecar to pray together in our various churches, celebrate our partnership as mission area parishes, and spend time with each other.

Our Pilgrimage will start at St Mary's Worsbrough Village at 10:00am and will call at St Peter's Hoyland (11.15) Elsecar Holy Trinity (12.15 where we will have lunch - bring sandwiches!) and end here at Wentworth with a short service at around 2pm. We expect the day to finish by about 2.30pm. The total distance is about 7 miles. All are welcome to join for all or part of the pilgrimage, or just to turn up at one or more of the churches for prayers and refreshments at the appointed time/s. Annual Parochial Church Meeting and New Electoral Roll

Every parish in the Church of England is required by law to hold an Annual Parochial Church Meeting. This is when the Parochial Church Council (PCC) who are trustees, present their accounts and report on their activities over the past year. It is also when we elect Churchwardens and new members of the PCC. Our meeting this year will be held on Sunday 26th April after the morning service in Wentworth church.

To be eligible to vote or to stand as a member of the Parochial Church Council it is necessary to be on the church's Electoral Roll. To qualify for the roll people must:

- a) Be baptised
- b) Be aged 16 or over
- c) **Either** be resident in the parish of Wentworth **or** have habitually attended worship in the parish in the last six months.

We encourage everyone who is eligible to join the electoral roll as an expression of belonging to our church community and commitment to our vision. If you joined the roll last year, there is no need to reapply.

Our Electoral Roll officer is Vanessa Arnold who will be administering the application process. Application forms will be available from 15 March. The closing date will be 29 March.

Confirmation Service at Sheffield Cathedral
