Each Sunday, we hope that you receive a very warm welcome into church, this welcome is even more important if it is your first visit to church, first impressions do matter.

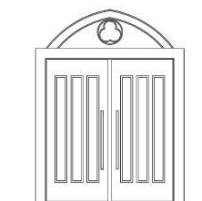

We have had a further meeting with the Church Architect Andrew Shepherd, to discuss our need to update the porch and the Toilets.

Introduction of new porch

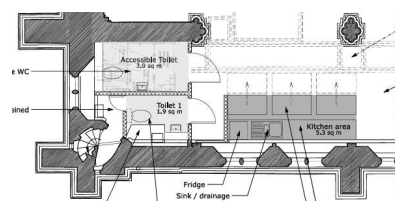
The existing porch was introduced into church during the 1970's, under the Vicarship of the Rev Cliff Dawson. Wentworth Woodworking, a local company, was contracted to construct the porch the owners being Lol West and Ernest Laister. Lol passed away some years ago and Ernest still takes an active part in village life. Over the years the porch has served well to help to reduce drafts through the North door. The proposed design will look more modern but still be very much in keeping with the church's grand Victorian design, made from oak and have a curved roof.



Introduction of Accessible Toilet

It is incumbent on the PCC to provide, wherever possible, facilities that are appropriate for all. The proposal is to turn the existing kitchen and toilet area into a standard WC and an Accessible WC, retaining the roof storage area.

Tea and coffee making facilities will be provided along the wall of the South Aisle. This will consist of a fixed unit next to the wall, with sinks and a fridge. It will be covered and locked when not in use. In front of this fixed unit will be a movable servery. In use it will be wheeled away from the fixed unit, giving access between the fixed and movable units. Two or three of the pews in the South aisle will be re-sited to give an open square seating area with tables.
